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## ***about the winery.***

After Several years of falling in love with the Barossa, Trevor and Marilyn Harch purchased the historic Tanunda Cellars bottle shop in the late 90's. Trevor expanded this wine connection by also getting involved in wholesale and retail liquor sales in Queensland, spending the following decade 'bringing the Barossa to Queensland'.

Never shy of a bit of hard work, throughout all this Trevor was also overseeing his well-established avocado and persimmon farm, whilst running the Sunshine Coast's largest construction company as co-founder and Managing Director.

With years of experience and knowledge in both the wine industry and the fruit growing business, the next logical step was to transition into growing grapes and have a go at producing his own wine. In 2007, Trevor jumped on an opportunity to purchase an established vineyard in Eden Valley's Keyneton.

The property 'Home Block' a working vineyard for over a century, was then producing Riesling and Shiraz grapes, boasting what is thought to be some of the oldest Riesling vines in Australia, planted back in 1896, alongside Shiraz vines dating back to 1927. Following his first 2008 vintage of a tiny 37 dozen Jack Harrison Shiraz (just to see what he had), Brockenchack excitement only grew when the exceptional quality of the wine spoke for itself. An avid wine enthusiast since his early thirties, after many years of 'research', Trevor came to his own conclusion that there really was no other wine that tasted as good as Barossa Shiraz! ...so why not make some yourself?

We are now the proud custodians of a superbly-sited historic Barossa vineyard, driven by the desire to feel the soil on our hands and to craft authentic, classically-styled wines that reflect our unique sites.

We achieve this by working with the region's hero varieties – Shiraz, Grenache, Mataro and Semillon – farmed using organic and biodynamic practices, handling our fruit respectfully in the winery with minimal intervention.

Our vineyards date back to the 1870s and have been the source of some of the region's flagship wines over several generations. We believe in doing things naturally, therefore much of our work is hands-on. We hand-prune and hand-harvest, managing all aspects in the vineyard with extreme care and attention to detail. Our vineyards are typically dry-grown with certain blocks supported by drip irrigation. We don't apply any unnatural fertilisers or sprays, farming our vineyards sustainably and organically (our Estate Vineyard in Stone Well is certified organic).

Visually beautiful with changes of colour from deep blue to blush pink when mixed with tonic water or a splash of lemon juice.

### **Opihr Spiced Gin 13.50**

Opihr is a legendary region famed for its wealth and riches which prospered during the reign of King Solomon. ### **Milagro Select Barrel Reserve Reposado 15.00**

The agave is harvested in prime condition, transferred to traditional clay ovens to roast which then produces a bounty that is then put through triple distillation. The resulting spirit is then aged in French Oak for 10 months which produces a Reposado with a honey amber colour that radiates from its hand-blown crystal bottle (please ask us if you would like to see).

### **Don Julio 1942 18.00**

Don Julio 1942 Añejo was created for the first time back in 2002 to celebrate the 60th anniversary of Don Julio and is the ultimate expression of the tequila art.

Made in the Añejo style, this tequila is made from the finest piñas, double distilled and aged for 24-30 months in small oak barrels. Rich, sweet aromas of caramel and toffee are layered with a fresh vanilla fragrance and hints of cherry-like red fruit.

## ***rum***

### **Bundaberg U.P.**

**9.00**

In 1888, an enterprising group of local cane farmers got together to form the Bundaberg Distilling Company. Standing the test of time, Bundaberg remains the home of Australia's rum, with every drop distilled, aged then bottled amongst its sun-drenched canefields.

### **Bacardi White Superior**

**9.00**

The most famous white rum in the world, a Cuban style but actually made in Puerto Rico, Bacardi is a light and clean spirit, filtered through charcoal for purity and aged in white oak for character.

### **Red Leg Spiced**

**13.50**

An authentic spiced rum from the Caribbean that is named after the Red Leg Hermit Crab who is native to the coral reefs of the area. Infused with ginger and vanilla before maturing in quality oak casks to smooth out the flavours and provide a long lasting finish.

### **Appleton Estate Signature Blend**

**14.00**

The 'Signature' is a flagship product of the Estate's Jamaica Rum Family. A blended rum combination of several rums of different styles and ages. Appleton Signature is made up of 15 different select aged rums, capturing the best of each styles.

From the early days of rum, overproof was the standard, crafted for a rich, full flavoured experience. Our distillery's founders continued this tradition with Bundaberg overproof rum. Distilled, aged in oak, then bottled at strength, it delivers an intense, bold character unlike any other rum.

### **Elements 8 16.00**

A modern rum of excellent quality from Saint Lucia where it is aged for 6 years in Buffalo Trace bourbon barrels which has a honeyed sweetness and dark, dried fruit flavour.

### **Bundaberg Reserve 17.00**

This old oak aged rum demonstrates outstanding character and is rich and dark with a hint of oak finish. Only released in small numbers, this rum is aged to its peak and released exclusively as a 'Bundaberg Reserve'.

Aged 12 years in the optimal rack-house position by Master Distiller, Fred Noe (Jim's great grandson), it's then barrel finished in Pedro Ximénez (PX) sherry casks, creating a drop of unique balance and character. Bottled at 100 proof, the result is a smooth, rich, full-bodied and mature bourbon.
